Christoffer Magle

Christopher Magle, deceased
Letters Testamentary granted to
Christopher Magle son of the deceased
and John Robert Cousins Executors
therein named they being first
duly sworn thereto
July 25th 1792.

In the Name of God Amen I Christoffer Nagle of the County
of Heidelberg and County of Bucks and State of Pennsylvania yeoman
being weak in body but of sound and Perfect Memory blessed be
Almighty God for the same do Make and publish this my last
Will and Testament in Manner and form following that is to say
1st I will and Order that all my just debts and Liens and charges shall
be paid of by My hereafter Named Executors

2nd I give and devise unto my Son Christoffer Nagle and to
his Heirs and Assigns all that My Marriage Settlement Tract
of Land Situate in the Place of aforesaid as in a deed under my
hand & Seal bearing my Ever date here with will appear

3rd I will that my said Son Christoffer shall Pay unto my here-
after named Children as follows to wit unto my Daughter Elizabeth
Catharina One year after my death the Sum of Twenty Five Pounds
and so on yearly Twenty Five Pounds the Second Payment
to Margaret the third unto My son George the fourth
unto my Daughter Eva and the fifth unto My Daughter
Maria Catharina the Sixth unto my Daughter Maria
Elizabeth Seventhly unto My said Son of five and
Eightieth also the sum of twenty five Pounds and on
the Eight year of bequeath unto my Daughter also Twenty
five Pounds Money of ^{Maria} for all these Sums of Money hereto
bequeathed be the said My son have all ready signed sealed
and delivered bonds to me by executing the deed to him
for the aforesaid Recompense to him devised

4th My said Son Christoffer shall give and Provide for me all and

during Life sufficient Mead drink apparel Laying
and Washing fitting for an old Christian and good
attendants in weak and sick Times

fifthly I will that No change shall be made for any Maintaining
Except Poor Goods is to be changed to my Estate

sixthly I will that all the Personally Estate shall be divided
amongst my Children hereafter named Share and Share alike
Allowing to my Son George one Spanish Milled Dollar for
his first Birth Right and No more

Seventhly I do hereby appoint Christopher Nagle My fornamed son of John
Echert Esq. Executors of this my Last will and Testament I
do hereby Null and void all former Wills by me made for
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
the twenty fourth day of May in the year of Our Lord One
Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety two
