 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold all
 that certain parcel of land situate lying and being in the State of the
 said and County of Cass, and known and distinguished in
 all of the County second district and section by (No 78) County
 ... containing ... to John A. Patriots of Franklin County Georgia
 ... and his heirs and assigns or administrators do warrant and
 defend the said tract or parcel of land unto the said John A.
 Patriots his heirs or assigns against the claim or claims of all other person
