and Six pence Sterling*
on the *Seventh day of July 1786*

And the said *Ephraim Clanton*
his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at
any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered
by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be re-
ceived in Payment.
