STATE OF GEORGIA.

By His Excellency *Charles J. M. Donald* Governor and Commander in Chief of the Army and Navy of this State, and of the Militia thereof.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING!

Know Ye, That in pursuance of the Act of the General Assembly of this State, entitled "an Act to lay out the Gold region, in the lands at present in the occupancy of the Cherokee Indians, into small lots, and dispose of the same by separate Lottery," passed on the 24th day of December, 1831, I HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT unto

Jacob Fitzger
of *Edwards* District *Franklin* County his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or lot of land, containing forty acres, lying and being in the Twenty-first district of the Second section in the county of Cherokee, in said State, which said tract or lot of land is known and distinguished in the plan of said district by the Number

Two hundred and Sixty

having such shape, form and marks, as appear by a plat of the same herunto annexed. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Lot of Land, together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereof, whatsoever, unto the said

Jacob Fitzger
his heirs and assigns, to *his* and their own proper

use, benefit and behoof forever in fee-simple.

GIVEN under my hand, and the Great Seal of the said State, this *twentieth* day of *November* in the year eighteen hundred and *thirty-nine* and of the Independence of the United States of America, the *Sixty-fourth*

SIGNED by His Excellency the Governor, this *20th* day of *Novem* 1839.
