W. Briant and wife Ann, William Nogle, John Nogle, Catherine Williams, Martha Burgess and Mary Setser heirs at law of Jacob Nogle the above described lands and tenements. To have and to hold the same to the said G. W. Briant & wife Ann, William Nogle, John Nogle, Catherine Nogle Williams, Martha Burgess, and Mary Setser forever in as full and ample a manner as he the said tax collector is empowered by virtue of his office to convey and assign the same.
