Whereas the tax assessed for the year 1887 on the following lands and tenements in Cherokee County to wit tract No. ----- in District 5th adjoining the lands of Jackson Montgomery on the South and on the East by the lands of J. D. Abbott and where Jacob Nogle lived during the year 1887 and assessed taxes as the lands Jacob Nogle containing 179 acres remained unpaid after the time limited by law D. T. Sudderth tax collector of Cherokee County levied on said land and the said tax collector after advertising and giving notice according to law sold said land to pay said taxes and cost at public auction at the court house in Murphy on the 7th day of May 1888. J. W. Cooper became the purchaser of the sum of five dollars and 35 cents and have paid the same and the said J. W. Cooper on the 4th day of May 1889 assigned for value his said bid to G. W. Bryant for the benefit of said Bryant and the heirs at law of Jacob Nogle. Now therefore this indenture Witnesseth that the said D. T. Sudderth Tax Collector for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars and 35 cents to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell to the said G. W. Bryant and wife Ann, William Nogle, John Nogle, Catherine Williams, Martha Burgess and Mary Setser heirs at law of Jacob Nogle the above described lands and tenements. To have and to hold the same to the said G. W. Bryant & wife Ann, William Nogle, John Nogle, Catherine Nogle Williams, Martha Burgess, and Mary Setser forever in as full and ample a manner as he the said tax collector is empowered by virtue of his office to convey and assine the same. Intestamony whereof the said D. T. Sudderth tax collector hath hereunto set his hands and seal the 21st day of May 1889.
