County in the State of North Carolina, aged 50 years,
5 feet, 10 inches high, Fair complexion, Blue eyes,
Brown hair, and by Occupation a Farmer was enlisted by
A. H. Davidson at Murphy, N. C. on the 24th day of
September, 1862, to serve Two years, and is now entitled to dis-
 charge by reason of being Over aged.

The said Jacob D. Welch was last paid by D. S. Mount
 to include the 31 day of August, 1862, and has pay due
 from that date to the present date.

There is due to him Twenty Dollars traveling allowance,
 from Danaw Station, the place of discharge, to Murphy, N. C. the
 place of enrolment, transportation not being furnished in kind.

There is due him Pay from 1st Sept 1862 to 10th Nov 1862
 He is indebted to the Confederate States Nothing Dollars,
 on account of nothing
